Dear Policyholder:

As Commissioner of Insurance it was my duty to place State National Fire Insurance Company (SNFIC) into Rehabilitation due to their financial condition. This action was taken to make sure all eligible policyholder claims would be paid. Pursuant to law, the Louisiana Insurance Guaranty Association (LIGA) has been activated and any claim you have under your SNFIC policy will be paid up to a maximum of \$500,000, with a limited exception. The status of your policy has not changed and you should continue to pay your premium when it is due to maintain your coverage. I am working with the court appointed Receiver to determine if the State National policies can be moved to a new and financially healthy insurance company.

You should know that LIGA is the entity that will now administer, adjust and pay all claims. LIGA has now loaded all claims data regarding SNFIC property claims into the LIGA system so they can resume adjusting and paying claims. The Receiver of SNFIC and LIGA have been working together to ensure outstanding claim checks issued are honored by SNFIC's bank. At my direction, the team of SNFIC and LIGA have acted swiftly to place money into the SNFIC bank account to cover all previously issued and outstanding claim checks.

The Receiver of SNFIC and LIGA have customer service personnel to answer any questions you may have about your policy or your claim. Below are phone numbers you can use to get answers to any insurance or claim questions you may have:
